## Thursday

Die GARTEN TULLN / Danube Promenade

Discover Garden Art and Nature in Tulln: "DIE GARTEN TULLN – Europe's first ecological garden show is one of Lower Austria's top destinations. Seventy extraordinary show gardens offer inspiration, relaxation, and knowledge. Guided tours provide valuable tips on sustainable garden design. A stroll through the idyllic riparian forest leads to the Donaulände, Tulln's most beautiful public garden, with highlights such as the danube stage and creative floral, tree, and garden installations by the city gardeners.

## Friday

SHOPPING IN TULLN / TULLN FOOD MARKET / BOAT RIDES AT THE WATER PARK / PICNIC

Tulln combines shopping, dining, and history: The historic main square and charming shopping streets, with their restaurants and outdoor seating areas, as well as the Rosenarcade, invite you to linger. On Fridays, the food market offers regional specialties. The city center can be explored on your own or through special themed tours. For children ages 8 and up, the "Tulu" puzzle adventure with a camel offers exciting insights into the city's history.

The extensive network of waterways can also be explored by boat along approximately 4 km of waterways, surrounded by diverse riparian and aquatic plants as well as the floodplain forest.

## Saturday

TULLI EXPRESS / CITY MUSEUM / VIRTULLEUM

Experience Tulln by tour train: The TULLI EXPRESS takes passengers to some of the most interesting sights in this garden city on the Danube—also available as a hop-on/hop-off tour!

A stop at the City Museum offers fascinating insights into the city's Roman past. The Virtulleum enhances the experience with an interactive city expedition—supported by the free Virtulleum app. Under the title "The Legacy of the Grave Robber," the diary of a grave robber can be deciphered during a walking tour through Roman Tulln. The mystery rally offers a playful discovery tour through ancient Tulln.

# Sunday

## CUISINE / RELAXATION

Culinary delights await at Tulln's renowned award-winning restaurants, rustic inns, and idyllic outdoor dining areas. Enjoy the unique sunset over the Danube, for example, on the inviting picnic lawn, on the flower-lined steps at the guest harbor, or at the climate-friendly Nibelungenplatz - perhaps with an ice cream from the traditional family-run Gelato Battistin, a relaxing sundowner at the Segafredo pop-up stand, or on the Süddeck.

Between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m., you can stop by the tourist information office to pick up tips for a wonderful day in Tulln and purchase Garden City souvenirs.

## ART / EGON SCHIELE / HUNDERTWASSER'S "RAINY DAY" SHIP

Experience art inspired by Schiele: The Egon Schiele Trail leads from his birthplace near the main train station to the former elementary school on Kirchengasse. Culinary highlights, such as the Schiele cake at Wagner's pastry shop, round out the experience.

The floating artwork and residence "Regentag" by Friedensreich Hundertwasser is anchored in the Tulln guest harbor and can be viewed from the outside. It gives visitors an authentic glimpse into the artist's life during his numerous travels.

## E-BIKE TOUR / RELAXING IN AUBAD / ACTIVITY PROGRAM

Explore the Garden City by bike: Three garden bike tours and several other exciting cycling routes invite you to explore the region on two wheels. Maps, useful information, and up-to-date details about the bike paths are available at the tourist information office.

On warm days, the Aubad on the Donaulände, with its expansive recreational park, offers ideal opportunities for sports, fun, and relaxation. The recreational offerings are complemented by mini-golf, a trampoline, a skate park, padel tennis, and much more—perfect for active explorers and families.
