Donaulände

Tulln's most beautiful public garden invites you to stroll and relax with blooming flowerbeds, picnic areas and cosy seating right by the Danube.

Regentag

The famous ship of the artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser, the Regentag, which was his home for ten years, is located right next to the boat landing stage in the guest harbour.

Nibelungenplatz & Nibelungendenkmal

The newly redesigned, climate-friendly Nibelungenplatz impresses with attractive ecological planting and a pleasant atmosphere. The Nibelungen Monument commemorates the famous legend.

DIE GARTEN TULLN, Europe's first ecological garden show, invites you to explore 70 naturally designed show gardens. Enjoy blooming landscapes and stunning views over the Danube wetlands from the treetop walk.

Main Square

The historic main square forms the heart of the old town. Outdoor dining areas, shops, ice cream parlours and a Mediterranean flair create a particularly pleasant atmosphere.

Egon Schiele Museum

The Egon Schiele Museum is dedicated to the life and work of the famous Austrian artist. It presents his early works and personal stories.

Minoritenkirche

This late Baroque church is one of the most beautiful sacral buildings in Lower Austria. Particularly impressive are its magnificent frescoes, the Loreto Chapel and the mysterious hermitage.

Tulln City Museum / Roman Museum

Tulln is one of the oldest towns in Austria and was already an important Roman cavalry fort. "Comagena" means "by the bend in the river". The Roman Museum and the historic Roman tower tell the story of 2,000 years of history.

Wasserpark

The Tulln Water Park is an extensive wetland area in the middle of the town, ideal for walks and relaxation. It combines a nature experience with recreation directly by the Danube and offers boat trips through its waterways in summer.
